The morning session is for beginners, as well as for those whose aim is to improve steps, dance technique and gain confidence in dancing basic formations.

The afternoon session is for more experienced dancers who have a secure knowledge of the basic formations, including reels (of 3 and 4) and who can identify corner positions. This knowledge will be assumed so that the teacher can concentrate on developing further skills and knowledge. Several of the figures taught will be from the evening Social Dance programme.

The expectation is that all participants will wear footwear appropriate for Scottish Country Dancing ie ideally ghillies or ballet style shoes, for the safety of all taking part. Shoes with hard soles and heels will not be permitted.
